ENERGETIC COMMUNITIES ASSOCIATION INC. is a key driver of Community Owned Renewable Energy in Queensland, aiming to put community energy on the roofs of community buildings, businesses and not for profits, as part of a drive to a more sustainable society. We work with community groups helping them develop their plans for community energy. We also liaise with other community energy groups and all levels of governments to promote energy policy that supports communities in a Just Transition.

COMMUNITY OWNED RENEWABLE ENERGY (CORE) is where communities themselves raise the funds, thereby providing up front capital for renewable energy installations (be it solar, wind, biodigesters or storage) on the roofs, paddocks or storage sheds of nearby businesses, not-for-profits or the local council. The host site then refinances the loan or pays for electricity through often cheaper electricity bills. The community investors get a return on investment, so profits stay in the community. It's a win-win-win for the environment, the local community and the local economy.
