- **Decarbonise** our energy supply
- **Decentralise** and localise our energy supply
- **Democratise** energy governance through community ownership and participation
- **Demonstrate** that renewable energy works and that it's what the community want.

In partnership with Bargara Brewery, **ENERGETIC COMMUNITIES** is developing Bundaberg's first **Community Renewable Energy Project**. We are holding an introductory workshop on **Community Owned Renewable Energy** on the Friday night and a second workshop on the Saturday, at Bargara Brewery, to begin the process of establishing community solar on the roof of the brewery.

Together we can take control of our energy systems. We can decide on, build, operate and own our own electricity assets that power our homes, businesses and towns. Thousands of communities around the world are doing this right now.
